â€¢ Ask for a revision using the critique.

Copy-ready prompt:

Draft [output]. Then critique it for clarity, accuracy, completeness, and persuasion.

Finally rewrite it using the critique.

Quality check:

â€¢ The critique is specific.

â€¢ The rewrite fixes the issues.

â€¢ The final version is tighter.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
