Quality check:

â€ Meaning survives.

â€ Removed details are named.

â€ Version fits channel.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
