Quality check:

â€ Claims are separated by confidence.

â€ Sources are included.

â€ Unverified claims are marked.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
