A chart prompt should say who will read it and what decision it supports.

Best way to use it:

â€¢ Define audience.

â€¢ Name decision.

â€¢ Ask for chart choice and labels.

Copy-ready prompt:

Recommend the best chart for this data and decision: [data/decision]. Explain why, required fields, labels, and what misleading chart to avoid.

Quality check:

â€¢ Chart matches decision.

â€¢ Labels are specific.

â€¢ Misleading alternatives are named.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
