Review this UI idea for accessibility. Cover keyboard navigation, labels, contrast, focus states, error messages, and screen reader concerns: [UI].

Quality check:

â€¢ Accessibility notes are concrete.

â€¢ Form errors are covered.

â€¢ Keyboard flow is included.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
