â€¢ Request why each idea fits.

Copy-ready prompt:

Brainstorm 20 ideas for [goal] under these constraints: [constraints]. Rank the top 5 by impact and effort.

Quality check:

â€¢ Ideas respect constraints.

â€¢ Ranking is justified.

â€¢ Top ideas can be executed.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
