Generate names for [product/category]. Criteria: [criteria]. Avoid: [words]. Provide rationale, risks, and tagline options.

Quality check:

â€¢ Names fit positioning.

â€¢ Risks are noted.

â€¢ You still check trademarks.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
