- â€¢ Review or update memories when your workflow changes.

Copy-ready prompt:

Suggest which preferences from this workflow are worth remembering and which should stay temporary: [workflow/preferences].

Quality check:

- â€¢ Only durable preferences are saved.

- â€¢ Sensitive details are excluded.

- â€¢ Temporary project facts are not over-generalized.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
