Compare [options] in a table using these criteria: [criteria]. Include best fit, limitations, cost/risk notes, and a final recommendation.

Quality check:

â€¢ Criteria match your decision.

â€¢ The recommendation explains tradeoffs.

â€¢ Weaknesses are included.

DropTicks note:

Use ChatGPT like a workstation, not a magic answer box. Give it the role, goal, input material, constraints, expected output format, and review criteria. The stronger your workflow, the better the result.
