The most useful AI teams do not only write prompts. They package workflows.

A reusable skill is a focused instruction set for a repeatable job: review a pull request, prepare a product brief, convert a document into social posts, validate a data mapping, or run a release checklist.

Good skills include:

1. A clear purpose.
2. Inputs the agent should expect.
3. Steps the agent should follow.
4. Tools or files the agent may use.
5. Output format.
6. Review criteria.
7. Examples of good and bad outputs.

This matters because teams waste time recreating the same context. Skills turn that context into a reusable operating asset. They also make AI behavior easier to review because the instructions are versioned and visible.

For DropTicks, skills are a natural product layer. They can support internal delivery, customer workstations, content workflows, code review, documentation, research, and operations.
